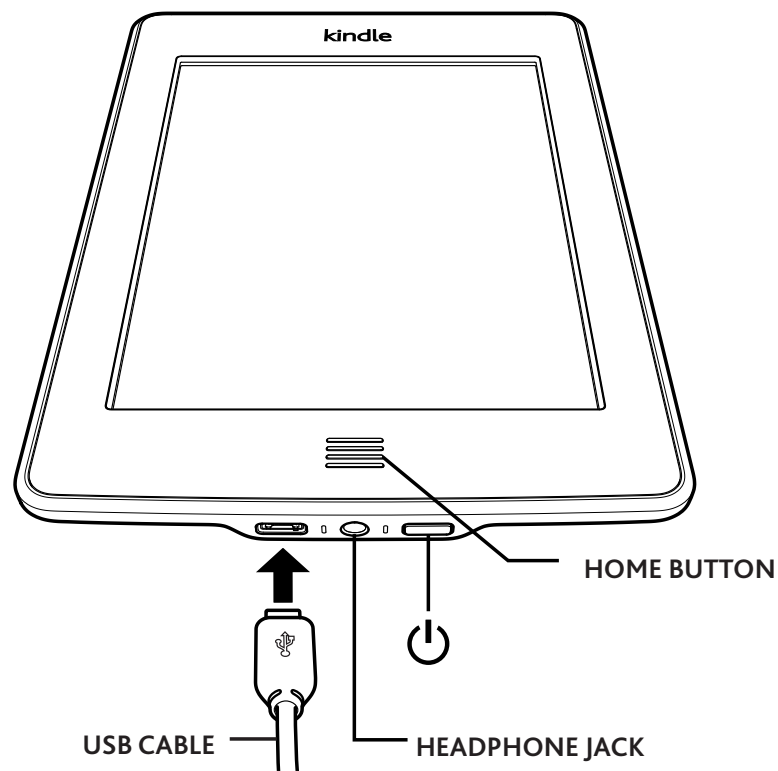


getting to know your kindle
